You will receive access to other services including gambling support, psychology, medical care, physiotherapy and nutrition.

Mirikai is for people aged 18-35 who have successfully completed a detox program. Once treatment is complete, you will have the option to transition into 1 of our 4 community **Transition Houses** for up to 12 weeks.


