The Role

We are seeking Doctors and Nurse Practitioners with an interest in end of life care to work with our team of experienced nurses at Hopewell Hospice.

This is a casual position, with flexible working hours. It will be on a rostered basis and involves one visit per day with phone availability. The Doctor typically spends 1-3hrs at the Hospice daily depending on Resident numbers and complexity. There is scope to expand this role in the future.

Our previous GP's have successfully combined this role with their existing practice, by calling in on their way home or in the evening and providing phone support.

Providing clinical care for residents in our community-based Hospice.
