HOPES (Healing, Opportunity, Prevention, Education, Sexual abuse service)

Information for Department of Child Safety, Youth and Women

HOPES provides therapy to:

- children and young people under 18 years who have experienced abuse (sexual, physical or emotional) and/or neglect
- children 12 years or younger who display problem sexual behaviours
- non offending family members or carers.

We offer a flexible and responsive service using:

- child centred, family focused, strengths based and trauma informed interventions
- individual and family support to respond to issues and associated coping needs
- advocacy and referral to relevant services.

Length of intervention

In the HOPES program the length of intervention varies depending on the complexity of the child's needs. This can vary from short to long term.

Referral process

The HOPES program is a free service to clients referred by Department of Child Safety, Youth and Women Services from the following Child Safety Service Centres:
