Response Narrative

I had pleasure again in reviewing 50 year old Vijay Engineer in Cardiology Outpatients again. He is currently awaiting Coronary Artery Bypass surgery at the Bay Hill Hospital.

Since I last saw Vijay, 6 weeks ago, he has continued to have angina at approximately 2 to 3 times per week despite the increase in beta blocker. He has started to use sublingual nitrates with his angina although still has not quite mastered the full nitrate protocol, and so I have again gone over aspects of that today. At present he has been using 1 sublingual tablet and then going to bed rather than following through with up to 3 nitrates over 15 minutes and calling an Ambulance if required.

Unfortunately Vijay continues to battle unsuccessfully with his smoking despite currently trying Champix, nicotine gum and continuing his 25 cigarettes per day habit. He has indicated today he will explore private hypnotherapy as he has had some success with this in the past.

On examination today the regular is 75 and a blood pressure of 165/90. His chest was quiet but with no evidence of heart failure. ECG confirms sinus rhythm with Q waves visible in V1 and V2 leads.

I have asked him today to increase his Norvasc from 5mg to 10mg per day. Additionally I have prescribed him a Nitrate patch of 25mg per day to be worn during the daytime.

I will make contact with the surgeon at the Bay Hill hospital, to make him aware that Vijay has ongoing symptoms despite increasing medical therapy and at this stage I plan to review him in 5 weeks time.

I have asked him to review with you in approximately 3 weeks time and if despite the increase of Norvasc and the Nitrates he is still having ongoing predictable angina the next recourse would be to increase his beta blocker further to 75mg twice daily.

Beyond that I think my next additional therapy would be Nicorandil but dearly this gentleman needs an intervention on his coronary arteries and the sooner that can happen and importantly the sooner he can stop smoking to make that a more successful procedure the better.

Do you need to obtain consent?

When should I view the individual's My Health Record?

Healthcare providers are under no legal obligation to use the My Health Record system. It is up to the healthcare provider and his or her clinical judgement as to when and how they use the system. However, examples of when it might be relevant to see if a patient has a My Health Record are outlined below.

Patient Consent

- A provider is authorised to view a record when providing healthcare to the patient
- A provider is authorised to upload clinical documents without gaining consent of a patient each and every time
- Best practice is to discuss with patient if the document contains sensitive information





Evolution of Prescriptions





What are electronic prescriptions?



- Electronic prescriptions are an alternative option to paper prescriptions.
- Previously, only a paper prescription signed by a prescriber has been the legal form by which medicines can be supplied.
- Paper and electronic prescriptions meet both the relevant Commonwealth, state and territory legislation.
- Electronic prescriptions are not mandatory.
- Patients and prescribers are able to choose between a paper and electronic prescription.




Electronic Prescriptions – token and active script list

Token

- Subjects of care may elect to manage their tokens on their mobile devices.
- The mobile device will display the token in a manner suitable for scanning using existing pharmacy equipment.
- Progressively available since May 2020.

Active Script List (ASL)

- A token management solution.
- Dispensers can access an electronic prescription for a patient from an ASL following proof of identity.
- ASL overcomes the issue of lost tokens and assists medicine management and adherence.
- Available from late 2020.





Staged Implementation of Electronic Prescriptions

- The Agency and industry have developed a staged approach to national implementation.
- Software vendors have prioritised implementation according to the staged roll-out plan.
- Broadly, these stages are:
 - Communities of Interest (COI) Complete
 - All of Victoria from 24/09/2020
 - Metropolitan Sydney from 21/10/2020



Secure Messaging

Secure Messaging Industry Offer

- \$30,000 was made available to Australian CIS and Secure Messaging Suppliers to accelerate the adoption of:
 - FHIR API federated look up of healthcare providers
 - Implement HL7 standard message payload envelopes
 - Implement acknowledgment (ACK)
 - Implement SHA2 certificates as SHA1 is unsupported in 2022
 - Manage the expiry dates of the certificates (notifications)

Service Registration Assistant (SRA)


- Enable healthcare and related organisations to maintain an authoritative version of their health service offering(s), location and practitioner details.

- Provide common identifiers for matching and linking when using the federated directory search capabilities.

SRA PURPOSE

- The purpose of the SRA is to streamline the process of registering practices and other healthcare services with external services.
- The SRA puts healthcare provider organisations in control of the information that is made available to third parties about their healthcare services.


