This project:

- provides five Northern Gold Coast general practices with renumeration, training, support, and access to a
 new Northern Gold Coast service which assists patients who are experiencing distress and may be at risk
 of suicide.
- supports practices registered for the Practice Incentive Program (PIP) to implement a quality improvement activity.

To join the Northern Gold Coast Community Suicide Prevention Service referral and working group.

- Gain confidence and be supported to assist people at increased risk of suicide

- Receive free training on suicide prevention

Background

GCPHN has commissioned Wesley Mission Queensland to provide a new Community Suicide Prevention Service. The non-clinical service has been codesigned to directly connect and link participants to the supports they require to reduce levels of distress and reduce the risk of suicide.

Purpose

The referral and working group is being established to provide feedback in the pilot phase of this service. It will be comprised of a select group of general practices and community organisations and groups who will be supported to make referrals to the service.

- Please detail how your practice services the Northern Gold Coast area
- What previous experience does your practice have regarding suicide prevention and what would the practice like to gain from participating?
- Please detail staff who will be available to attend training and nominated general practitioner to attend working group meetings?

Commitment required

- One training session (GP, practice manager and a frontline worker)
- Participation in two hour working group meetings, monthly for approximately six months (GP)

\$5000 per practice
