This practice is working with your Primary Health Network (PHN) to further improve the quality and safety of care.

General practices are busy and it's not always easy to predict which patients are most at risk of poor health. This general practice shares health information with the PHN who review the data, using a tool called Primary Sense, to find patients who might benefit from extra attention.

Identifiable information such as your name, full date of birth or address are not shared with the PHN as these are not necessary for the analysis.

Primary Sense works in the background and notifies your GP when:



new results come in that have increased your risk of becoming unwell



treatments could be provided to reduce your risk of becoming unwell



you would benefit from a health check to keep you well

Only data to help keep you well is shared. Primary Sense is designed by GPs for GPs.
