

Focusing on Primary Sense GP prompts for beginners

General Practitioner prompts

- Prompts may appear when a GP opens the patient's record in the clinical software. These prompts are specific to each patient
- They only contain 3 items at a time, and these have been given clinical priority in order of appearance
- When one element is actioned that allows a subsequent element to appear on the next prompt
- The more information section provides a rationale for the prompt, and relevant details for cross referencing by the GP







GP prompts cont.

- As prompts are more frequent than alerts, they stay
 visible for three minutes. This prevents multiple
 prompts being opened on a GP's screen at one time.
- GPs can click 'give me more time' to re-set the three minutes.
 - GPs can also retrieve the prompt from the My Prompts History. Through here, they can also further review/change the selection options.





GP prompts cont.

- Due influenza vaccination
- Due pertussis vaccination
- Due Meningococcal vaccination
- Due Hepatitis A Vaccination
- Consider Haemochromatosis testing
- Missing CV Risk Medication
- Due Heart Health Check Assessment
- Due Microalbumin Pathology
- Due Care Plan
- Due Mental health care plan
- Due Medication Review
