Provider Connect Australia (PCA)What is it?




PCA is **not** a directory. It enables healthcare provider organisations to maintain an authoritative version of their service delivery details and publish those details to business partners that support their service delivery. By providing a source of accurate service delivery details, the PCA seeks to:

- Improve the consistency and accuracy of information held about healthcare services by business partners such as clinical directories, messaging service providers, Medicare, diagnostic service providers, insurers and funders
- Enable the federation of directories by providing the necessary common identifiers for healthcare services
- Provide easy access to accurate and trustworthy healthcare service information to enable the effective and reliable addressing of electronic communication
- **Increase the uptake of health identifiers** to the benefit of the broader healthcare system
- Dramatically uplift the completeness, timeliness, accuracy and availability of healthcare service information across the healthcare system

Provider Connect Australia (PCA) – Next steps



- PCA Pilot completed
- The ADHA and the Department of Health and Aged Care are working together to provide early access to PCA to general practices currently registered with Vaccine Clinic Finder (VCF) Connect
- VCF Connect will be decommissioned on 30th June 2023
- Practices that have claimed their VCF Connect sites will be contacted directly by the ADHA and prompted to register so any details can be transferred across
- Practices that have not claimed their VCF Connect sites will be contacted by GCPHN. There may still be some information in VCF Connect the Dept has transferred across for you meaning a benefit in registering before 30th June



What is the 'my health' app?



'my health' is an application which can be used to access key health information in My Health Record.

- You can install and use the 'my health' app on a mobile device wherever you have an internet connection.
- The 'my health' app lets you download documents from My Health Record onto your mobile device.
- The app also lets you share documents that contain your health information with other people or organisations



Exploring the my health home screen




The **my health** home screen displays several tiles that let you easily access your health information.

You can select from these tiles to view, download or share your:

- Clinical documents
- Personally-entered information
- Medicare information





Using the medical history timeline




The medical history tile lets you filter the information in your record by year and category.

You can select from the following categories:

- Immunisations
- Documents
- Allergies and reactions
- Test results
- Scans
- Medicines
- Hospital visits
- Medicare services
