GCPHN are looking for a Primary Health Care, General Practice Nurse to join us at the Essential Health Summit in Adelaide, 25-27 July.

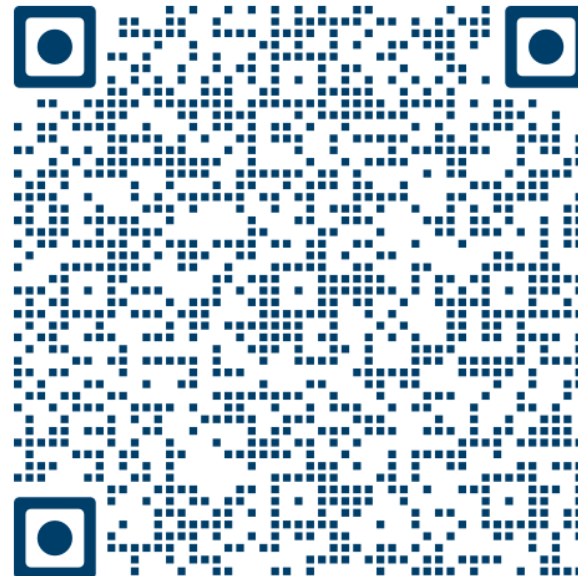
