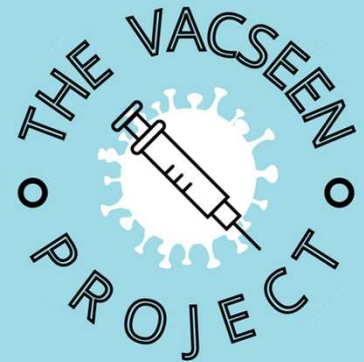

Our Vision & Purpose

Accessible, high-quality health care for all

- Providing preventative and primary health care services free of charge.
- Establishing innovative programs and models for delivering health care, particularly in non-traditional spaces.
- Collaborating and providing ongoing support to community members and organisations assisting in the provision of health care services.



Our Story

2021-22

- Influenza & COVID-19 pop-up vaccination clinics across Brisbane, the Gold and Sunshine Coasts, Toowoomba, Ipswich and Bundaberg
- We give a 'RAT' Program
- Successfully lobbied Queensland Health to allocate 1500 free influenza vaccines to ten organisations that support the health of people experiencing homelessness (including ourselves)

2023

- Continuation of vaccination clinics
- General health clinics to Toowoomba and Brisbane
- Establishment of our Mental Health Initiative
- Pharmacy Program - eScripts could be sent to partner pharmacy, and medications were dispensed free of charge

2024

- Focus shifted onto health clinics - Toowoomba, Brisbane, Gold Coast, Sunshine Coast and Bundaberg
- Continuation of Mental Health Clinic
- VaxWorks collaboration for free influenza vaccinations at the Gold Coast

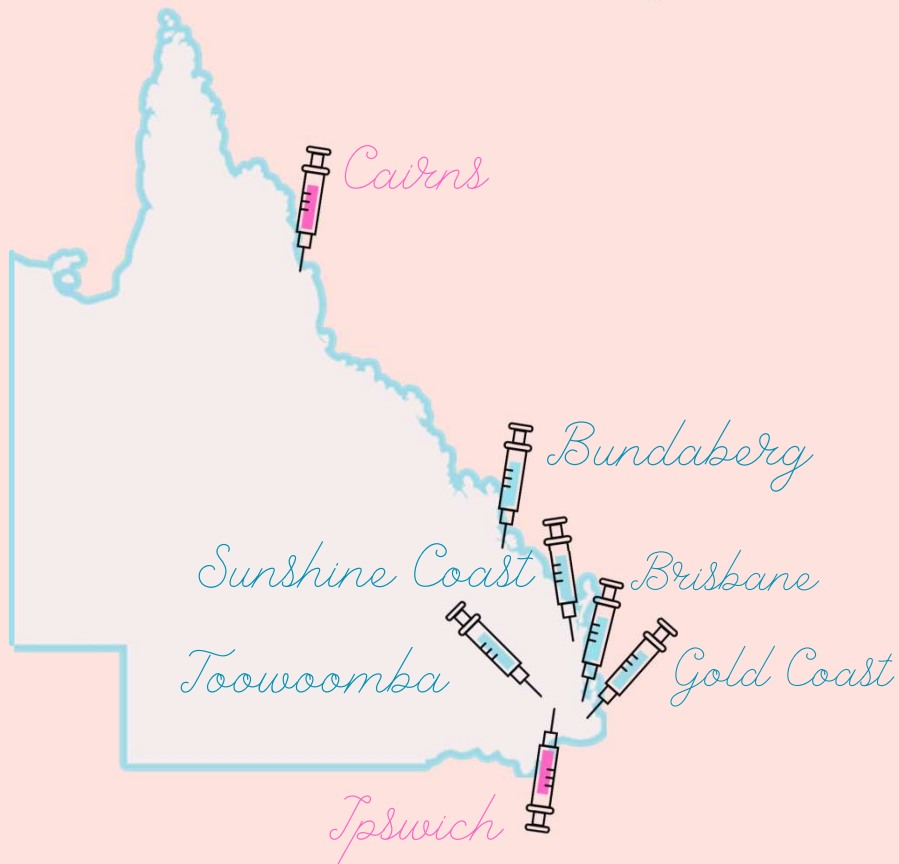

Homeless Health Clinics

- All led by local heads and medical student volunteers
- GP led with an emphasis on primary care
- Wide variety of presentations
- Each clinic operating for 2 hours, 2-3 times per month - seeing 5-10 patients per clinic

Current Initiatives

Mental Health Clinic

- In conjunction with Brisbane North Psychologists, clinic is run by social worker, volunteer counsellor and psychology student
- 15-20 patients each clinic
- Most common presentations: substance use/abuse, grief and loss, trauma, PTSD
- Provides assessment, referrals and brief interventions while facilitating access to longer-term bulk-billed psychological care.
