Pressure injuries are a largely preventable but unfortunately common occurrence. Their development is reportable under the National Safety and Quality Health Service (NSQHS): Comprehensive Care Standard. In this interactive workshop, participants will learn practical strategies, collaborate with peers, and gain valuable insights to enhance their practice.

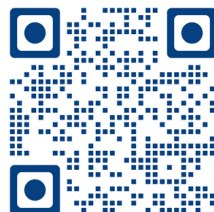
This workshop is specifically for nurses working in residential and community aged care services in the Gold Coast region.
