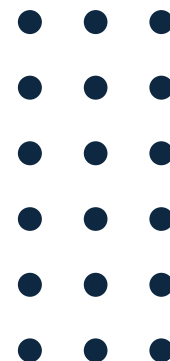

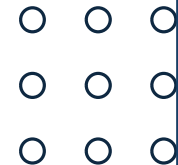
The GCPHN Clinical Placements Team Role

- **For Medical Placements:** Bond University and Griffith University
- **For Nursing Placements:** Griffith School of Nursing and Midwifery and Southern Cross University

GCPHN acts as an intermediary organisation to coordinate core medical and nursing student placement in general practice.

Medical Students Placements



👉 Introductory student's years 1 & 2

Placement duration:

3 set days over 3 weeks
6 x 3-hour sessions

👉 Griffith final year students

Placement duration:

6-week placement – 2 to 3 days per week
26 x 3-hour session



👉 Year 3 students

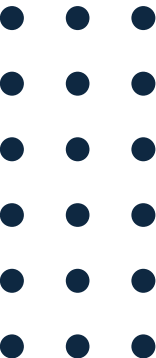
Placement duration:

3 set days over 3 weeks
6 x 3-hour sessions

👉 Bond final year students

Placement duration:

7-week placement – 2 days per week
28 x 3-hour session



Placement supervision can be shared between GPs
Teaching payments of \$200 per session (1 session = 3 hours)

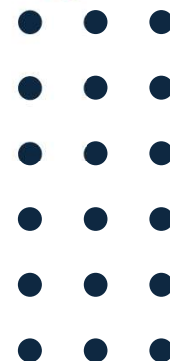
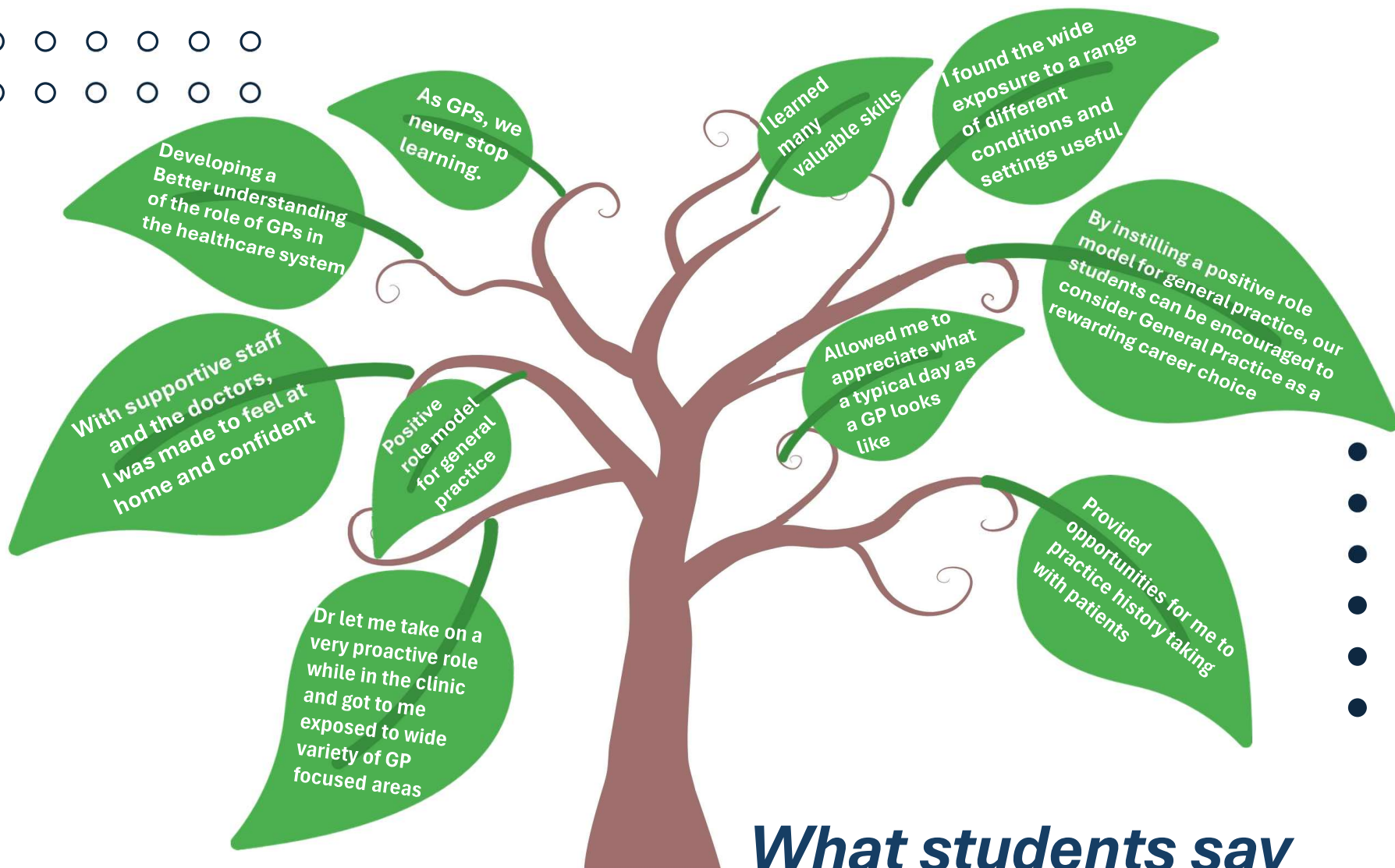
