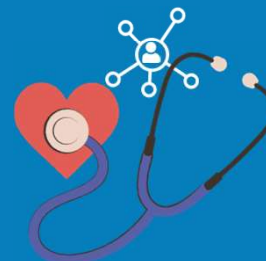


PHASES WITH PRIMARY SENSE PROJECT EOI
